There are four areas of online safety that we will learn about called the 4 C's.


<p><b><u>Content</u></b></p> <p>This area is all about what you post online and what you look at online. Is it appropriate for your age?</p>	<p><b><u>Contact</u></b></p> <p>This area is all about who you are speaking to online. Do you know them?</p>
<p><b><u>Conduct</u></b></p> <p>This area is all about how you act online and how other people act towards you. Are they being kind? Are you being kind?</p>	<p><b><u>Commerce</u></b></p> <p>This area is about being tricked online to either buying things, gambling or tricks websites use to get your money.</p>
