

Appendix A: New behaviour principles- Covid 19 Recovery Plan 2020


In light of the need for children to behave differently when they return to school following the period of Covid-19 lockdown we have amended our behaviour policy.

Behaviour policy changes will be communicated to pupils immediately on return to school, with parents (via our school portal in advance of our partial re-opening date) and staff (during staff training on Monday 22nd June 2020).

These are our new school rules that will help us all stay safe together;

- Children will follow designated routes when entering and exiting school and whilst moving from their bubble to outdoor space.
- Children will follow school instructions on hygiene, such as handwashing (you can practise this at home).
- Children will only socialise with the children in their own bubble group.
- Children will follow instructions regarding moving around the school as per specific instructions (for example, one-way systems, out of bounds areas, queuing).
- Children will follow the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' rule and will need to avoid touching their mouth, nose and eyes with hands.
- Children will inform an adult if they begin to feel unwell.
- Children will follow expectations about sharing any equipment or other items including drinking bottles.
- Children will follow the new expectations regarding outdoor play.
- Children will follow the rules regarding using the toilets.
- All children must follow the clear rules about coughing or spitting at or towards any other person.

• All children must follow the clear rules for staying at home and accessing the remote education offer;





• Children will be sent home should they persistently and knowingly ignore these rules (this decision will be taken by the duty *Designated Safe-guarding Lead* on a case-by-case basis). Access to remote learning will be activated.
