





If you could please share the following key points at the meeting, I would be grateful...

- The HAF programme is for 4-16 year olds in receipt of benefits related, free school meals
- The offer for Children and young people is 4 hours of activities per day, for four days a week, for 4 weeks over the summer holiday period
- Holiday clubs commence on Monday 25th July and run over 4 or 5 weeks
- Some of the clubs have age restrictions (due to insurance or activities)

The flyer attached outlines the providers and areas confirmed so far though the actual delivery venues may change slightly due to capital works being done in the schools. This flyer will be continually updated on our website and we will share the link as soon as venues are properly confirmed.

As ever, if there is any school who already works with a provider/holiday club, please do let me know and we will approach them. No success unfortunately with existing providers in Euxton and Buckshaw though we are keen to expand delivery into these areas.

Grateful if you could encourage colleagues to consider **directly refer** any children who are at significant risk of food poverty over the summer OR those children who may not qualify for free school meals, but may be otherwise vulnerable as we do have some flexibility.

Please also encourage any Head or school to get in touch if we can help at all- we will! What worked especially well over Easter was schools whose MOF worker collated list of children who would benefit, and then checked with us whether they were booked on. If they weren't then they would chase the family and encourage them to book on to provision.
